- What we have scheduled to finish out this year

 - Playground upgrade for k-2 budget \$40,000 for next year
 - Outdoor classroom
 - 24-25 school year we are getting help from Home Depot through their adopt a school program will work on drainage and grading, fixing the benches
 - 5th graders for legacy project will paint benches and beautify the area
 - Learning resource library Have ordered \$2,000 worth of resources, working on a check out system to implement in the school by the end of this year. Materials to be included: books, flashcards, learning games
